**Sponsored Internship – Data Analyst

The World Food Programme (WFP) is the leading humanitarian organization saving lives and changing lives, delivering food assistance in emergencies and working with communities to improve nutrition and build resilience. We are currently seeking to fill an Sponsored Intern position at Vulnerability Analysis and Mapping (VAM) unit, Angola Country Office, RBJ, based in Luanda, Angola.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE DIVISION:

The VAM unit in Angola has been providing technical assistance to the Ministry of Agriculture and Forest in developing food and nutrition security assessments through on-the-job training and mentoring in food and nutrition security related matters. Recently, the Country Office started the development of a food and agriculture input data collection platform and has trained provincial staff (enumerators) on data collection using kobo toolbox. The next step will be the preparation of data cleaning processes and a data visualization platform using Tableau followed by a training of Government staff at the central level on how to access and analyse the food and agriculture input prices when required.

The unit is also responsible for carrying out post-distribution monitoring (PDM) through household surveys using mobile data collection (MoDA) and SPSS for data processing. In addition, the unit produces maps for the programme units when required.

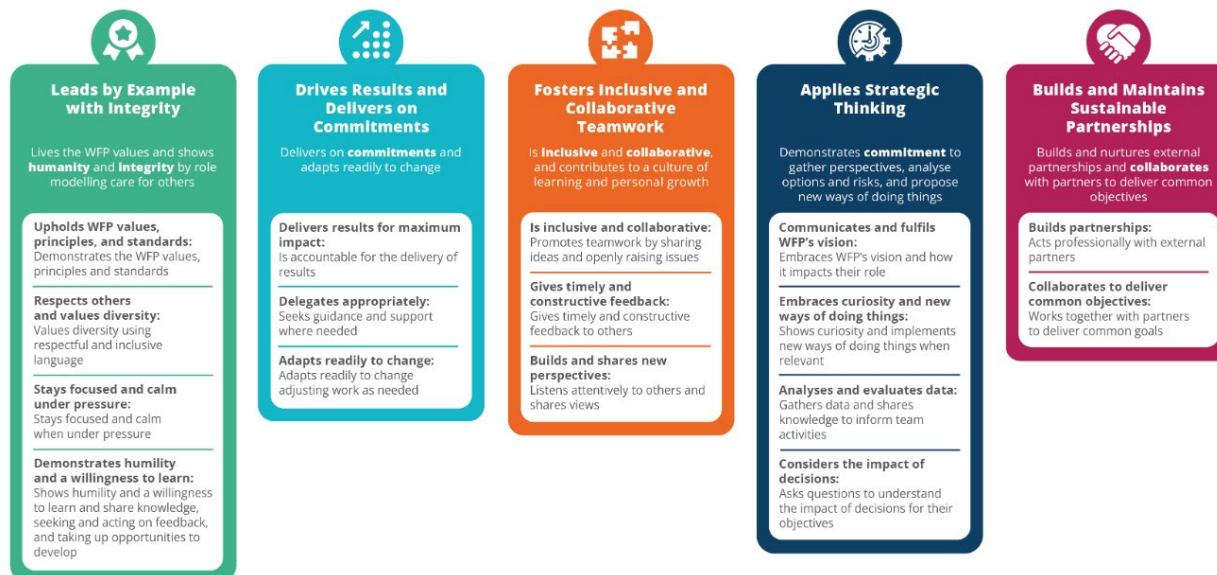
LEARNING ELEMENTS
